





ROMAN BLINDS

Roman Blinds offer a softer look than other styles of blinds and can be matched to verticals and rollers. Motorisation is available for Roman Blinds for both safety and convenience.

- Panel size approximately 180mm 200mm
- Minimum width with cord, cord lock or chain drive 600mm
- Minimum width with 240v motor 680mm
- Minimum width with rechargeable Li-Ion motor 760mm
- Maximum width 3000mm
- Minimum drop 900mm
- Maximum drop 3000mm
- Minimum stack height 260mm
- Available with control options include standard cord and cleat, swivel cord lock, deluxe cord lock, chain drive or motorisation.
- 4 headboard sizes are available 40mm (standard), 70mm, 90mm and 120mm (additional charge applies)
- Hem option available
- Child safe compliant motorisation
- Aluminium Back Batten Slide on back battens are used instead of sewn pockets and punched eyelets. This eliminates needle holes in blockout fabrics. Aluminium back batten blinds are made without side hems.







Surface dust may be removed with a gentle brush, feather duster or clean dry cloth. To remove tougher stains or smudges, a mild solution of lukewarm water can be used then wipe with a clean dry cloth.

An art gum rubber is excellent for removing small marks.








CELLULAR SHADES

The most energy efficient Internal Blinds on the market Air is trapped in the honeycomb cells, slowing down the transfer or air (warmer in winter cooler in summer)

- All fabrics are made from 100% polyester material Single & Double Cell Skylights & Shapes are available for unique situations (Photo and drawing needed to confirm individual windows)
- Varying control and stacking option
- Colour Coordinated head box & bottom rail
- Extremely compact projection and stacking
- Select from translucent to block out fabrics in a variety of colours and designs
- Aluminium and steel head and bottom rail with plastic caps on both top and bottom
- Fabric is constructed of polyester, has good insulation properties and is easy to clean
- · Honeycomb blinds contain an auto balance mechanism to ensure the bottom rail is always level
- Choose from: standard corded, cordless, clutch, top down bottom up, day/night, motorised and skylight blinds
- Cellular shades are not suited where blinds will be continually moist as mildew can form
- Block out fabrics block 99% of visible light and 99.9% of UV rays.








CELLULAR SHADES

- The unique structure of the cellular blind means that air is trapped in the honeycomb cells which means you are able to keep your house warm in the winter months and cool in the summer months.
- Cellular blinds have superior energy efficiency and durability and are a fantastic modern alternative to roller blinds.
- Cellular blinds are great for a 'light filtering' effect, and also come in blockout cell with the alternative for either single or double cell styles. The light filtering range will maintain your complete privacy, whilst offering a subtle light inside your home during the day. Blockout cellular blinds will provide you with a complete room darkening solution and will offer increased energy efficiency.
- Over 30% of heat can be gained during summer, as well as lost during the winter time through our
 windows. For this reason, window coverings, are a vital part of combating your house's ability to remain
 energy efficient in either extremes that the weather can bring. Installing a cellular blind in your home,
 will improve your insulation dramatically as the unique honeycomb structures trap heat during summer
 and prevents heat loss during winter.






STANDARD CORDED

• Cords open blind from bottom up only




TOP DOWN BOTTOM UP CORDLESS

• Tab operation on top and bottom rail




TOP DOWN BOTTOM UP CORD/CORD

• Left cord releases top down function Right cord draws blind up




CORDLESS

General Cleaning


Your Cellular shade may gather dust and from time to time need cleaning. Use a hair dryer on cold to gently remove dust, or use an anti-static soft brush or cloth to gently attract dust from the fabric.

Spot Cleaning

The Cellular shade fabric should be treated carefully and gently when spot cleaning. Use a damp cloth with a very mild detergent and gently "dab" the affected area. Harsh rubbing will remove the stiffening and possibly the colour of the fabric and distort is surface. It is vital that the fabric not be creased during this process.

Insects

Occasionally insects may get trapped and die in the blind cells. Use a hair dryer on cold and blow through the



COMPOSITION 100% Polyester

DENSE STRIPE 75mm height / 0.32mm thick **LOOSE STRIPE** 50mm height / 0.24mm thick **LIGHT FASTNESS** 4 grade (ISO 105 B02)

Chain operated: raise and lower by chain only.

- Chains must always be attached to recess or wall with a Child Safety Clip.
- Surface dust may be removed with gentle brush, feather duster or clean dry cloth.
- A mild solution of lukewarm water may be used to remove stains and smudges. Wipe with a clean dry sponge.
- An art gum rubber is excellent for removing small marks.

General Cleaning


Your Contour shade may gather dust and from time to time need cleaning. Use a hair dryer on cold to gently remove dust, or use an anti-static soft brush or cloth to gently attract dust from the fabric.

Spot Cleaning

The Contour shade fabric should be treated carefully and gently when spot cleaning. Use a damp cloth with a very mild detergent and gently "dab" the affected area. Harsh rubbing will remove the stiffening and possibly the colour of the fabric and distort is surface. It is vital that the fabric not be creased during this process.

Insects

Occasionally insects may get trapped and die in the blind cells. Use a hair dryer on cold and blow through the ends of the cells to remove the insects. Leaving insects inside the cells when drawing the blind up may cause the fabric to mark.
