

## In Home appointment Guidelines

### People who are Vaccinated or Medically Exempt

The NSW Government has amended the state-wide restrictions for Vaccinated people on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

Visitors and Renovations of homes where people are living can resume across NSW in all LGAS with the following restrictions:

- Proof of Vaccination or Medical Exemption is shown upon arrival to our representative
- Masks to be worn
- General COVID safe practices (Social distancing etc)

### People who are NOT vaccinated

Renovations of homes where people are living can resume across NSW in all LGAs with the following restrictions:

- In an outdoor area, no more than five persons can undertake work at the same time;
- In an indoor area, no more than two persons can undertake work at the same time; and
- if work is occurring in an indoor area on the premises, and other persons (such as members of the household) are present at the premises, the other persons must stay in a separate indoor area of the premises from the persons undertaking the work at all times.

We kindly request for:

- Social Distancing during interactions
- Masks to be worn at all times during your Consultation.
- If you have an outdoor area or entertaining space please direct our Consultant to this area to discuss the details of your requirements as Outdoor ventilated areas are more Covid Safe. If this is not possible the consultant will need to leave you unattended in another room to view samples etc.
- Gloves and Sanitising Spray or Wipes will be provided for you to clean samples prior and after viewing
